Great event hosting doesn't happen by magic. The host must be fully up to speed on the topic, speakers, audience composition and sponsor's needs.

He's hosted events such as JLL's TEDxSydney VIP Lunch through to awards nights, offsite days and interviews with distinguished guests.

Panel hosting requires preparation, pre-work and, on the day, managing the conversation so that contributions from guests are shared around and they have the opportunity to shine.

For offsites, you may want to package in a keynote or other services to dramatically lift the quality of the experience at an attractive marginal cost.


