

AV, SETUP & TRAVEL RIDER

Phil's presentations are a mix of education and entertainment, and they rely heavily on the right audio-visual set-up to ensure your audience gets the maximum value, inspiration and motivation.

Phil will bring his own laptop (Macbook Air) with the necessary output adapter and his own clicker, with the presentation (run from Keynote) ready to go.

He will also bring Keynote, PPT and PDF back-ups on a USB drive - although Keynote is his preferred program due to the quality of video and slide transitions.

If you require his presentation to run from your equipment in PowerPoint, please advise Phil at least five days prior to the engagement and allow sufficient time for checking and testing on the day.

Phil's presentations require:

- High-definition screen projector
- Wi-fi connection
- Good quality audio system (sound will run from the computer)
- Handheld microphone is preferred, lapel is next best
- MC / host to introduce as per the supplied and agreed script, as this sets the scene for the audience experience

On stage, it's preferable if he has stage area free of a centred lectern.

For virtual presentations, Phil can present from his home studio or you may choose to hire a professional studio in the vicinity of his location at the time for him to present from.

Phil requires travel and all relevant expenses such as airfares, parking, transfers, accommodation and meal allowances ex-Sydney Airport.
